SOCIAL SECURITY'S TICKET TO WORK PROGRAM SUPPORTS CAREER DEVELOPMENT FOR PEOPLE AGES EIGHTEEN THROUGH SIXTY-FOUR WHO RECEIVE SOCIAL SECURITY DISABILITY BENEFITS—S-S-D-I OR S-S-I—AND WANT TO WORK. THROUGH THIS FREE, VOLUNTARY PROGRAM, ELIGIBLE PARTICIPANTS WORK WITH SERVICE PROVIDERS TO GET THE SUPPORT AND SERVICES NEEDED TO FIND AND KEEP A JOB AS THEY MOVE TOWARD FINANCIAL INDEPENDENCE THROUGH WORK. THE PROGRAM REGULARLY SHARES INFORMATION FOR PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES.
